Scholarship List

Nan Knox Scholarship

- This scholarship is awarded to all eligible members enrolled in a traditional 2-year/4-year college or university pursuing an associate or bachelor's degree
- Award given each semester; max 8 semesters
- \$250 per semester within Tri-county area (Broward, West Palm Beach, and Miami-Dade);
 \$500 per semester out of Tri-county area

Gamesh K. Parsard Memorial Scholarship Fund

- This scholarship is only awarded to graduating members of the Marti Huizenga Club
- o One-time award; Amount varies

JM Family Enterprises Community Partner Scholarship

- This scholarship is only awarded to graduating members of the JM Family Teen Center who will be attending Broward College (BC)
- Award given each semester for 1 year (2 semesters); Amount varies

Rita & Rick Case Endowment Scholarship

- This scholarship is awarded to select members that have been accepted to Nova Southeastern University (NSU)
- Merit-based
- o Full Tuition; No housing or additional fees

Rick Case Vocational Scholarship

 This scholarship will grant supplemental scholarships to club members that are planning to enroll at a vocational/technical school or obtain a certification that will help them become employable



The Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County Scholarship Program will grant supplemental scholarships to Boys & Girls Club members that meet the eligibility requirements and submit the application and other required information by the **DEADLINE**: Friday, April 4. 2025.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicant must have been a member and in good standing with the Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County for the past two years.
- 2. Applicant must have been an active Club member during the past twelve (12) months leading up to the Scholarship Award Year.
 - a. Active Requirements

The Club Member must have attended the Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County 40 times (at least 40 hours) during the 2024-2025 program year. Virtual Teen Program hours will count toward this total.

The deadline to reach the attendance minimum is August 1, 2025.

- i. If the Club Member has not reached the minimum attendance but has met every other criterion then they will be considered a provisional scholarship recipient. If minimum attendance is not met by the deadline, the scholarship will not be awarded.
- 3. Must be a 2025 high school graduate with a GPA (Grade Point Average) of "C" (2.0) or higher. Cumulative GPA and copy of unofficial transcript are required when you submit your application.
- 4. Must have been accepted to a college, university, or post-secondary school (Vocational School). Proof of acceptance and a school schedule must be shared prior to award.
- 5. Completed Scholarship Application reviewed/signed by the Club Director.
- 6. Two completed letters of recommendation from any of the following: Club Director; Club Program Manager; Community Leader; Teacher; Minister; Coach; etc.
- 7. Must complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for the 2025-2026 School Year and provide your FAFSA score. Need proof of EFC number.
- 8. Completed Essay Questions Detailed instructions on page 8
- 9. Attendance is mandatory for Club members and their parent/guardian at the 2025 Scholarship Celebration. Further details will be announced.



IMPORTANT NOTES TO THE APPLICANT ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- The Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County Scholarship <u>will not support a student's complete financial needs.</u>
- Students must <u>maintain at least a GPA (Grade Point Average) of a "C" (2.0) or higher</u> to have their scholarship continue until graduation from their respective college or vocational school.
- Students must <u>send in their grades upon the completion of each semester</u> to have their scholarship continue until graduation from their respective college or vocational school. Checks take two weeks minimum to process. Timeliness of the award is dependent upon the student/member.
- No funds are available for graduate school.

REQUIRED INFORMATION - STUDENT CHECKLIST

All the following information must be received by the Scholarship Committee by Friday, April 4, 2025.

1. Completed Scholarship Application reviewed/signed by the Club Director

2. Two completed letters of recommendation from one of the following: Club Director, Club Program Manager OR Community Leader; Teacher; Minister; Coach, etc.

3. Must complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for the 2025-2026 School Year and provide the FAFSA score

4. Confirm two years of Membership and at least 25 visits by August 1, 2025.

5. Copy of most recent unofficial transcript which includes student name, cumulative GPA, and date. At any time, the scholarship committee can request updated transcripts. Final grades must be submitted at the end of the 2024/2025 school year for scholarships to be disbursed.
