

2025 Rick Case Vocational Scholarship Application



The Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County Rick Case Vocational Scholarship will grant supplemental scholarships to Club members that are planning to enroll at a vocational/technical school or obtain a certification that will help them become employable. Members must submit a completed application and any required information by the **DEADLINE: Friday, April 4, 2025.**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must have been a member and in good standing with the Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County for at least two years.
2. Applicant must have been an active Club member during the past twelve (12) months leading up to the Scholarship Award Year.
 - a. Active Requirements
 - i. The Club Member must have attended the Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County 40 times (at least 40 hours) during the 2024-2025 program year. Virtual Teen Program hours will count toward this total.
 - ii. **The deadline to reach the attendance minimum is August 1, 2025.** If the Club Member has not reached the minimum attendance, but has met every other criterion then they will be considered a provisional scholarship recipient. If minimum attendance is not met by the deadline, the scholarship will not be awarded.
3. Must be a 2025 high school graduate with a GPA (Grade Point Average) of "C" (2.0) or higher or recent alumni of BGCBC in good standing. Cumulative GPA and copy of unofficial transcript are required.
4. Must have been accepted to a vocational/technical school, certification program, or training program and provide proof of acceptance. Must provide proof of acceptance and a class schedule.
5. Completed Scholarship Application reviewed/signed by the Club Director. If alumni, please send in directly.
6. Two completed letters of recommendation from any of the following: Club Director; Club Program Manager; Community Leader; Teacher; Minister; Coach; etc.
7. Completed Essay Questions – Detailed instructions on page 7
8. Attendance is mandatory for Club members and their parent/guardian at the 2025 Scholarship Celebration. Further details will be announced.
9. If applicable, must complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for the 2025– 2026 School Year and provide your FAFSA score. Vocational/technical schools will accept FAFSA.

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IMPORTANT NOTES TO THE APPLICANT ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- The Rick Case Vocational Scholarship will not support a student's complete financial needs.
- Students must maintain at least a GPA (Grade Point Average) of a "C" (2.0) or higher to have their scholarship continue until graduation from their respective college or vocational school.
- Students must send in their grades upon the completion of each semester to have their scholarship continue until graduation from their respective vocational school or certification program.
- BGCBC alumni are eligible for the Rick Case Vocational Scholarship if all eligibility requirements are met: High School GPA, minimum two years of membership, and active member during Junior/Senior year.

- _____ 3. If attending vocational/technical school, must complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for the 2025-2026 School Year and provide the FAFSA score.
- _____ 4. Confirm two years of Membership and at least 25 visits by **August 1, 2025.**
- _____ 5. Copy of most recent unofficial transcript which includes student name, cumulative GPA, and date. At any time, the scholarship committee can request updated transcripts. **Final grades must be submitted at the end of the 2024/2025 school year for scholarships to be disbursed.**
